



NOTICE OF CHANGES IN RELATION TO COVID-19

Angourie Resort is a Registered COVID-19 SAFE Business. Our Safety Plan has been developed to safeguard the health and wellness of our guests and staff.

In line with the government regulations, we require that all guests register their details to assist with contact tracing. Angourie Resort has implemented options to do this, including either using your mobile device to scan the QR code, visit a website, or send an SMS. More details are provided at the venue.

The Cunjevoi Restaurant & Bar is currently open for dinner & lunch service opening 7-nights and the appropriate precautions are in place relating to social distancing, and health and safety. It is a requirement that patrons register their details to assist with contact tracing prior to entering the establishment. Entry will be denied should you refuse to adhere to this requirement.

The Essential Elements Day Spa is open for treatments. The appropriate precautions will be in place relating to social distancing, and health and safety. It is a requirement that day spa guests register their details to assist with contact tracing prior to entering the day spa. Entry will be denied should you refuse to adhere to this requirement.

The current reception operating hours are 7:30am – 8:30pm daily. Enhanced cleaning and hygiene practices have been implemented including comprehensive precautionary measures to safeguard the health and wellness of our guests and staff.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Any persons entering these premises agrees to comply with the following "Conditions of Entry", which have been implemented in accordance with the current NSW Public Health (Covid-19) Order relating to this premises for the purpose of keeping patrons and staff safe.

All Patrons attending this licensed premises shall:

- Register their details to assist with COVID tracing using various Contact Tracing Check-in Points throughout the resort
- Be refused entry if they display signs of illness
- Be requested to leave should they display signs of illness after entry
- Be seated whilst consuming liquor
- Adhere to social distancing as required including at entry and exit points or where markings are in place
- Comply with any request to relocate due to patron number restrictions in any area
- Comply with reasonable directions from staff
- Consider downloading the COVID-Safe App
- Adhere to a maximum number of ten persons per table

Failure to comply with any or all of these conditions may constitute an offence under the Public Health Order and the licensee, their staff or agents reserve the right to remove from the premises any patron not adhering to these conditions under Section 77 of the *Liquor Act 2007*.
